Position	Nature of Assignment
Editor – in - Chief	The Editor-in-Chief holds the highest editorial position within a publication or media outlet and is primarily responsible for overseeing the content, quality, and overall direction of the publication.
<b>Executive Editor</b>	The Executive Editor is a senior editorial position responsible for overseeing the daily operations of a publication and ensuring the editorial team delivers high-quality content consistently
Associate Editor	Editing and Proofreading Edit and proofread articles for grammar, clarity, style, and accuracy. Ensure all content aligns with editorial standards and brand voice.
Editorial Board Member	Editorial Board Member plays a crucial role in maintaining the quality, integrity, and direction of a publication, particularly in academic, scientific, or professional journals.
Member	Help maintain the scientific rigor and editorial excellence of the journal. Support the continuous improvement of editorial practices and procedures.
Reviewer	Providing an unbiased, objective evaluation of a manuscript, offering constructive feedback to improve the work, and ensuring the validity and integrity of the research. They must evaluate the scientific merit, originality, and relevance to the journal's scope. Reviewers also have a duty to maintain confidentiality and avoid conflicts of interest.
Session Chair	Managing a specific session, ensuring a smooth flow of presentations, and engaging the audience. They introduce speakers, manage the session's time, facilitate Q&A, and keep the session on schedule.

Conference Paper Supervisor	A conference paper supervisor's primary
	responsibility is to guide and support in the
	development, writing, and presentation of a
	conference paper. This involves providing
	feedback, ensuring academic standards are met,
	and assisting with the submission process.
Paper Evaluator	They must adhere to specific guidelines and
•	maintain confidentiality throughout the
	process. Key responsibilities include evaluating
	all answers, entering marks accurately, and
	ensuring the correctness of marks entered. They
	also play a role in identifying discrepancies and
	potential unfair means during the evaluation.
Seminar Paper Evaluation	The primary responsibility in seminar paper
•	evaluation lies with the assigned faculty member
	and often an external expert. They evaluate the
	paper's content, structure, originality, and
	adherence to writing guidelines, providing
	feedback to the author.
Paper Publication	Ensuring the integrity and accuracy of their
•	published research papers. This includes
	ensuring the originality of the work, citing
	sources accurately, and adhering to ethical
	publication practices. They are also responsible
	for communicating the research findings to the
	scientific community and, if appropriate, the
	public.
Author	Ensuring the originality and accuracy of their
	work, citing sources properly, disclosing any
	conflicts of interest, and adhering to ethical
	guidelines. They are also responsible for accurate
	contact information, particularly for the
	corresponding author.
Co Author	Contributing significantly to the research, sharing
	accountability for the work, and ensuring the
	accuracy and integrity of the published
	paper. They are expected to collaborate on all
	aspects of the research, from design to analysis,
	and contribute to the overall intellectual content.
